



## **Team Ambrose Backs Sammy Roth for YRLC Chair**

He is currently the national committeeman for the District of Columbia Young Republicans and is on the Hill staff of Senator Olympia J. Snowe. He earned a business administration degree from Colorado State University and is now pursuing his Masters in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College.

Roth also serves us as a member of the U.S. Navy Reserve.
